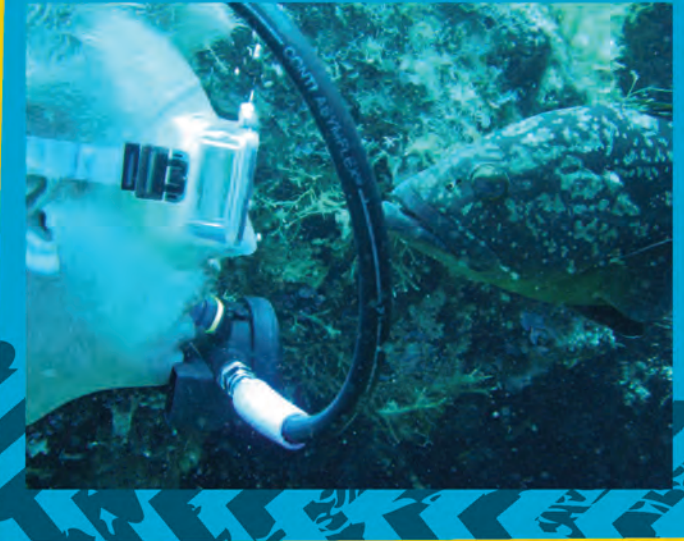


## DIVER SAFETY

# SCUBA DIVING in NORTH CYPRUS

North Cyprus, with one of the longest diving seasons in the Mediterranean and with attractive underwater world hidden in its unexplored and unpolluted waters welcomes you. The crystal-clear and warm waters of North Cyprus can provide an underwater visibility of more than 30 meters. North Cyprus with water temperature reaching up to 30 degrees Celcius, hosts a large variety of marine life. The historical richness of North Cyprus is reflected visually in its underwater diversity and you will be enchanted by the unforgattable adventure down in the deep. Once you are in the right area, you will have the opprtunity to see grouper, sea turtle, parrotfish, moray eel, octopus, leerfish, stingray, scorpion, seabream and many other species.



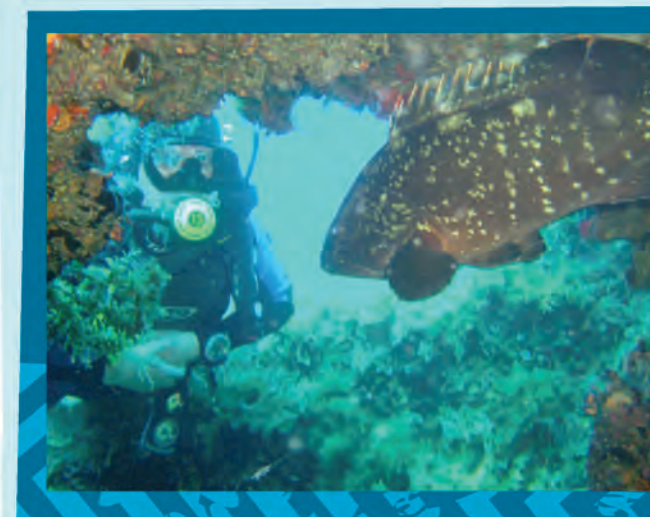
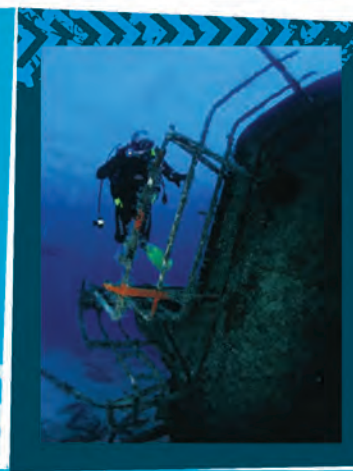
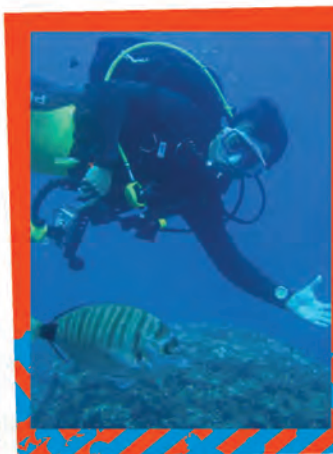
## DIVING CENTRES and COURSES

There are 10 professional diving centers in North Cyprus in Girne, Gazimagusa and Karpaz regions. These diving centres with their qualified and certified divers who can speak English, German, French and Turkish organise daily diving programs for the experienced divers. Try dives are organised by our diving centers for those who would like to dive for the first time. If you are a beginner scuba diver interested in first time diving, then you will choose among internationally recognised and certificated courses like PADI, CMAS, BSAC, and SSI. After attending and completing the courses you can get your international qualification in 3 or 4 days. The more experienced divers can take courses like Open Water Diver, Divemaster, Night Diver, Search and Recovery Diver. It is possible for you to find such courses in the travel packages of your tour operator. Alternatively you can search and sign up for these courses directly from the local diving centers.



## DIVE SITES

On the North and East coasts of North Cyprus, you will find more than 30 different exciting diving sites where you can explore the diverse marine life, the beautiful corals, the mysterious shipwrecks and other hidden underwater historical heritage. From March until December, the crystal and warm seawater of North Cyprus provides you the opportunity to dive for 10 months throughout the year. The underwater world of North Cyprus awaits scuba diving enthusiast like you with its underwater visibility of more than 30 meters, average water temperature of 20 degrees Celsius and unbelievable variety of marine species hidden at different depths. However, some of the diving centres keep on giving service all year round because the water temperature doesn't fall below 15-16 degrees Celsius.
